Volunteer Opportunities with the CCTA

You bring the talent and enthusiasm, we'll provide the training as needed, and together we'll keep tennis the sport for life moving forward in Cook County.

Facilities – putting up and taking down windscreens, filling cracks, repairing and adding to bleachers, keeping weeds from around fence, putting up and taking down bulletin boards.

Writing – anything from writing articles for the local newspapers to preparing material for flyers and preparing text for publications.

Grant Writing – writing grants to support programs and tennis court construction.

News and public affairs – anything from being a volunteer news reporter for tennis events and programs to taking pictures at tennis activities. Pictures would be sent to local newspapers and placed on our website.

Graphic Arts – designing posters, flyers, entry forms, newspaper and publication ads.
